## Office Hours

The Shiloh office will be open as follows:  
**8:00-4:00, Monday through Friday.**

## Activity Fee

**The fees need to be paid before the first day of practice in each sport during each season (example: fall – volleyball, winter- basketball, spring – baseball).**

- Participation in High School Level Major Activity - \$60/student/season
- Participation in High School Level Minor Activity - \$40/student/season
- Participation in Middle School Level Activity - \$40/student/season

Per family maximum of \$300 per year  
3 seasons per year = fall, winter, spring

**“Major” Activities** - Football, Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball, Baseball, Volleyball

**“Minor” Activities** - Speech Team, Cheerleading, Girls Soccer, Cross Country

## Attention Elementary Parents

With Early Bird Registration around the corner, we wanted to make you aware of our class request and class list policies:

**Class requests** - If you have a classroom request for your child, please have your request submitted to Tracy Friesen, registrar/technology coordinator, in writing or e-mail by the end of this school year (2009-2010). A verbal request cannot be honored as it needs to be documented. We will consider requests, but we will not guarantee requests. We gather input through a number of ways to be in the best interest of the whole class. We thank you for your understanding.

**Class list information** - Due to the privacy rights of families, school personnel can't accommodate the release of information from class lists except for information to a parent about his/her own child. If parents choose to do so, they may call other families to find out about classmates.

## Mall Promotion

**What to do:** Shop at Kirkwood Mall between October 1st 2009 and March 31st 2010. Take your receipt to the Customer Service Center located on the north end of the mall (outside of I. Keating Furniture) within 60 days of your purchase. A Customer Service Representative will record how much you spent, stamp your receipt and return them to you.

1st place: \$2500.00, 2nd place: \$1500.00, 3rd place: \$1000.00

**OFFICIAL RULES:** Customers can only use Kirkwood Mall store or restaurant receipts towards the promotion. Receipts must be recorded within 60 days of purchase. Receipts must be dated from October 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010. Receipt total, including tax, is eligible for credit. Store gift certificate and gift card purchases are not eligible for credit. Soliciting/collecting of receipts on mall property is prohibited. Participating schools earn one (1) point for every dollar of valid store receipts unless otherwise specified by Kirkwood Mall. Anyone who intentionally abuses the program will have their school terminated from the program and the school will not be eligible to receive a cash prize.
